

## Venuca Evanan (Lima, 1987)

Venuca Evanán is a 33 year old self-taught artist. She draws and paints everyday life depictions on wood. Her art is expressed on the Sarhua boards, which are a form of Ayacuchan art declared a Cultural Heritage of the Nation on October 29, 2018. However, Venuca's work breaks conventions: it's usually men who paint these boards, and she is one of the first women to do so. On these boards, she portrays the life of migrants, men and women from the countryside, but above all, she brings visibility and empowerment to women.

Through her work, Venuca Asunción Evanán Vivanco captures moments, reflects on our environment, and addresses issues that may bother many. In mid-2020, she created the first Sarhua board depicting a same-sex love story. In this LGBTQ+ themed board, a couple is seen traveling through the Peruvian Andes. A rainbow appears in the sky, and the sun shines on them. Symbolically, two rivers converge beneath a mountain, just like their love. Venuca draws on recycled wooden boards to protect the environment. "An original Sarhua board measures between two and four meters in length and is made from wild logs. Tradition dictates that they depict a family's genealogy," she explains. These famous boards originate in Sarhua, an Ayacucho community that was affected by terrorism. Traditionally, they are given during the roof-raising of a house and placed on the main beam of the new home. This is followed by celebrations with music and chicha (a traditional Peruvian beverage). However, the tradition has migrated and spread across the country, and now people seek out Venuca to create customized works. She makes Sarhua boards in various sizes and price ranges. One board can measure between 70 centimeters in height and 13 in width. Once she is told the story to be depicted, she can translate it into the board with hand-drawn illustrations and the Sarhua aesthetic.


